Glenn Skuthorpe in Bulgamada Concert

Coming to the Blue Mountains on Saturday August 24 is Glenn Skuthorpe, a masterful storyteller and compelling performer. A Nhunggabarra, Kooma, Muruwari man from Goodooga in north west NSW, Glenn is an award-winning singer-songwriter with six highly regarded albums and a string of Australian and international festival successes to his name.

Glenn will feature in a concert entitled Bulgamada, which means 'mountain water' in Dharug language. The concert is a celebration of indigenous song writing, music making and story telling. Also featured are local Dharug songwriter Jacinta Tobin and storyteller and songman, Lexodious Dadd. A 100-voice choir and band bring additional songs from Rachel Shields, Archie Roach and Kev Carmody.

Although I'm only 22, I've been given the unique opportunity to perform the role of the undertaker in Blackheath Theatre company's upcoming play.

'It's My Party and I'll Die If I Want To' is a fast-paced comedy that's as black as it gets. The effort going into this performance is massive. Each rehearsal I'm encouraged to push my limits further to bring the character to life. And it's not just the actors that are putting in the hard yards, this performance has a whole team of people off-stage supporting and designing it. There's a buzz in the air when a group of like-minded people all gather together to create something as exhilarating as this. Everyone's had their part to play in building this completely absurd, hilarious and desperately human performance. The story is simple. Conservative and emotionally unavailable Ron Patterson thinks he's going to die tonight, so he invites his barely functional family around for a pat on the back before his death - it doesn't quite go to plan.
